**Wheelie Bars Required on all Tractors
(cannot be attached to hitch)**

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. Stock crankcase must conform to make and model of tractor. Owner must show parts numbers in parts book to confirm. Factory replacement allowed.
2. Tractor must have stock type head and manifolds.
3. Carburetor must be of stock type and bolt to stock manifold without adapters or modifications.
4. Contest is open to tractors with rubber tires, no dual wheels, no four-wheeled drive, no tire studs, chains, or cut tire except face of cleat.
5. The tractor operator must be 16 years of age or older or possess a tractor safe operator certificate.
6. Each tractor may be entered only once in each class.
7. Drawbar is to be stationary in all directions and a maximum of 20 inches from top of hitching device to the ground.
8. Drawbars must be equipped with a hitching device not more than one inch in thickness and must have a three-inch diameter opening. Pulling point may not be more than 1 ½ inches from back edge of the hitching device.
9. No pressurized tanks allowed except LP gas. No oxygen or alcohol fuels allowed.
10. All engine radiators must be properly shrouded.
11. All exhausts must discharge upward above the higher point of tractor and be securely attached unless standard manufacturers specifications differ.
12. No portion of the tractor shall interfere with the sled or sled hitch during a pull.
13. All weights must be safely secured to the tractor. Any external parts or weight lost while under the green flag will be cause for disqualification.
14. No weight frame or weight may be extended 24 inches beyond front of tractor.
15. All tractors must be equipped with a hood and grill.
16. Maximum speed shall be 3 miles per hour. Speed shall be determined by a pace device.
17. The use of torque converters, automatic shifts, etc., will be permitted during the pull.
18. Operators must remain seated during the pull, and must have complete control of the tractor at all times.
19. All pulls must start from a tight hitch - no jerking permitted.
20. Tractors must be stopped immediately upon signal from the judge.
21. Tractors must remain within boundaries of contest course during the pull or be disqualified.
22. Only one pull will be allowed each contestant unless a tie is declared.
23. The pull shall be considered over when forward motion of the load stops or when speed exceeds 3 MPH. The judge shall hold hole-digging to a minimum.
24. Contestants shall draw by lottery for pulling position in each weight class.
25. No alcoholic beverages are allowed on fairgrounds.
26. Contest to be governed by a judge with all decisions final.
27. Judge has the right to stop and disqualify any tractor if it is not being operated in a safe manner.

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28. The contest committee reserves the right to reject any or all entries.
29. A **\$10.00** entry fee will be charged for each class in which a tractor is entered. The fee is payable when the tractor is registered. **No refunds will be made after your class has started.**
30. Only the operator is to be on any tractor during a pull.
31. Fair Committee or Tractor Pulling Contest Committee will not be liable for injuries. All contestants are required to sign a waiver of liability.
32. The Contest Committee reserves the right to add weight and begin a class over at any point in the class.
33. Chairman has the option to close a class if there are fewer than three entries in any class.
34. Two starts will be given for changing gears or weights within 50-foot safety zone.
35. Contestant with breakage within 50-foot safety zone will fall in the rear of class for re-pull.
36. Committee reserves right to change rules if necessary.
37. All tractors must be weighed following a pull.

38. Failure to comply with the above rules disqualifies any contestant.
39. Five or more tractors are required to make a class.
40. No tire changing will be allowed!
41. 90% payback will apply for all classes.
42. Excessive loss of fluid during a pull will be cause for disqualification. An 18-inch, or greater, diameter circle will be considered excessive.
43. Minimum drawbar length 24 inches – from center of axle.
44. Number of cylinders must conform to original make and model of tractor.

Rules for Super Farm Turbo (Modified Stock and no Turbo)

1. Tractor must have stock or original chassis for model being entered. Chassis shall consist of clutch, transmission, rear end and differential housings. Must also have original style hood and grill in place.
2. Tractor is limited to one single stage 3-inch turbo charger. Three inches being determined as a 3-inch measurement at the opening of the compressor wheel.
3. Maximum size fuel pump being a P - pump.

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4. Maximum tire size is 24.5 - 32. Cut tires will be allowed, with the exception of double cut tires.

NO HORSEPOWER LIMIT

5. All tractors competing must be equipped with side shields, transmission scatter blanket and air shut off device.
6. All tractors must have wheelie bars and must have fenders. Wide front ends are recommended but not mandatory.
7. All tractors must be equipped with workable rear brakes.
8. All exhaust must discharge upwards with a minimum pipe length of 18" from the hood line.
9. Drawbar to be stationary in all directions. The maximum height of 20" and maximum length of 18" shall be measured from the center of rear axle to point of hook. Must have a 3" hole and not to exceed 1" in thickness.
10. No pressurized fuel allowed. Water injection will be allowed. (Tractor must use fuel that factory engine was designed for.) No oxidizers.
11. All fans must be factory shrouded or shrouded with 1/16" steel 360 degrees.
12. No weight or weight frame may extend more than 24" beyond the most forward point of the tractor. All weights and weight frames must be stationary and safely secured to the tractor. No weights may extend beyond the rear tires. No weights or brackets may extend more than 12" in width of tires.
13. No portion of the tractor may interfere with the sled or sled hitch during a pull.
14. Any ballast or external parts lost while tractor is in motion under green flag will be cause for disqualification.
15. All drivers must wear a D.O.T. approved safety helmet.
16. Contestants must be 18 or at least 16 years old with parents or guardians signed consent.
17. If there are any doubts or complaints about legality of an entry, track officials or officials in charge of the pull will make final judgement.
18. Tractors are also recommended to be equipped with a minimum of one 2½ lb dry chemical or halon type fire extinguisher fully charged in working condition and within operator's reach.
19. Tire size in No Turbo Class is 18.4-38.

1. Engines:
 - A. Limited to automotive type-maximum of eight cylinders per engine – 2 valves per cylinder.
 - B. Maximum blower size 8-71, no high helix blowers.
 - C. No aluminum engine blocks.
 - D. Blower belt shield required, blower restraint required if no waste gate installed.
2. On vehicles with multi-cylinder engines using starter ring between engines, the starter ring must be 360 degrees shielded with 1/4" steel and have both ends enclosed.
3. Harmonic balancers must be 360 degrees shielded and fastened with bolt. SFI approved balancers exempt from shielding.
4. Vehicles equipped with any type of clutch must have steel or aluminum fly wheel and use a blower proof bellhousing having no non-factory holes, drilled or cut in it – exception of a clutch maintenance/inspection hole and one 1" cooling hole and be equipped with a block saver plate of 3/16" steel or 1/4" aluminum. No cast iron components permitted. Components defined as flywheel, pressure plate, floaters/clutch disc(s). All automatic transmissions must have positive reverse gear lockout and a safety blanket installed (blanket must be in good condition).
5. Maximum length of vehicle is 15' from center of rear axle housing to the furthest most point of vehicle. Vehicle must have wide front axles. Front wheels must track within rear wheels.

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6. Hitch height is 20" for all vehicles in open class and length is minimum of 18" from center of rear axle to hook point. No clevis allowed on drawbar. Hitches must be rigid, in all directions. No movement is allowed while pulling. Drawbars must be parallel to the ground. Hitch must be horizontal – not vertical. Do not connect drawbars and stabilizer bars.
7. Maximum tire size of 30.5" x 32". Single cut or double cut tires allowed.
8. Competing vehicles must have working rear wheel brakes.

9. All exhaust systems must discharge vertically. Vertically is defined as being within 10 degrees (any direction) of being "plumb." Height shall be a minimum of 12" above bend in the pipe which discharges vertically, measured from the top of the pipe to the bottom of the bend.
10. Pulling vehicles must have an automatic ignition kill switch and/or shut off. Kill switch must be mounted independently of drawbar and/or wheelie bars. Kill switch to be mounted in the rear center of vehicle, 48" above and within 6" off center of point of hook. Kill switch for spark ignition engines – the kill switch must break or ground the ignition circuits and must break electric power to the electric fuel pump(s) if so equipped.
11. Pulling vehicles must have shield between the driver and the tires that consists of a solid barrier between the driver and any part of the rear tires. The barrier must be able to sufficiently support the weight of the driver and must extend a minimum of 6" horizontally at the top and be a minimum of 36" wide at the top.
12. All vehicles must be equipped with stabilizer bars. Stabilizer bars to have pads, not wheels on bottom of bars. Pads to be a minimum of 5 sq. inches. Pads to be a minimum of 32" rearward from the center of the rear end housing. Pads maximum of 10" off the ground. Outside to outside length of pads to be a minimum of 20". Minimum of 12" high bumper bars. Top to be fastened to stabilizer bar framing. Bars must support weight of tractor for weight class being pulled.
13. All weight frames and weights must be stationary and safety secured to the vehicle. Frames or weights must not extend rearward beyond the rear tires or exceed 12" beyond the width of the rear tires. No weight on vehicle rear or deck within 8" of drawbar hook point.
14. All vehicles with an exposed drive shaft must have the universal joints enclosed with 6" wide, 5/16" minimum steel or 3/8" aluminum, round, with the inside diameter not greater than 2" more than the outside diameter of the largest universal joint.
15. Legal fuels are gasoline, water and alcohol. All forms of nitro-methane including nitrous oxide and propylene oxide are illegal.
16. Vehicle must have a rollover protective bar or cage that is at least as high as the top of the driver's head/helmet. Rollover protection must be fastened at least two points to the rear axle housing. Factory style flip down tops allowed. Rollover protection must be able to lift one rear wheel when pulling horizontally from the top of the bar/cage without damage to the rollbar/cage.
17. Fire extinguisher is required.
18. Driver must wear helmet and fire suit (jacket and pants).
19. All pullers must be signed up 30 minutes before the pull starts.
20. Must leave track under own power or prior arrangements for pull back before hookup to minimize time.

LAWN STOCK

Rules:

1. Contest open to stock tractors only!!!!
2. Tractor must have stock hood, grill and be stock in appearance with all safety shields in place or of equivalent replacement.
3. Maximum tire size 23 x 10.5 x 12. 8 x 15" or 16" economy, speedex, case, etc.

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4. 10" drawbar height. Height must be stationary in all directions and be parallel with the ground.
5. Front weights may not extend more than 24" forward from the center of the front axle.
6. Tractor must have an operating governor.
7. Pump gas ONLY.
8. Tractor must have a muffler or straight pipe pointing upward, vertical (no rain caps).
9. Contest is open to individuals 10 years of age and older.
10. Tractor must be privately owned and equipped with rubber tires only – no duals.
11. Contest committee reserves the right to reject any and all entries.
12. Tractor weight will be determined by weighing immediately following each pull.
13. Each tractor may be entered only once in each class.
14. No cut tires will be permitted.

15. Wheelie bars are required.
16. Added weights cannot extend past rear tires.
17. 14 hp maximum.
18. No valasity stacks.
19. No electric fuel pumps.
20. No gas pedals.
21. 4000 RPM limit.
22. Twin cylinder engines are allowed.
23. **NO YOUTH ALLOWED IN ADULT CLASSES.**

MODIFIED STOCK

Rules:

1. Tractor must be privately owned and equipped with rubber tires only – no duals.
2. Tractor must be regular manufactures model.
3. Contest committee reserves the right to reject any and all entries.
4. Tractor weight will be determined by weighing immediately following each pull.
5. Tractors hitching point shall not be more than 10 inches from the ground line at the point of hitch.
6. Contestants will be allowed only one pull in each class.
7. All pulls will start from tight chain.
8. Each contestant shall furnish his own clevis.
9. Contest is open to any individual, 10 years of age and older.
10. Officials and tractor operator only permitted in the pulling area.
11. **EACH TRACTOR MAY BE ENTERED ONLY ONCE IN EACH CLASS.**
12. Maximum tire size allowed will be:
 - (a) 12-inch rim – 23" x 10.50" tire
 - (b) 15" – 16" rim – 800 x 15 or 800 x 16 tire
13. No cut tires will be permitted.
14. All original equipment safety shields must be in place.
15. Wheelie bars are required.
16. Failure to comply with rules disqualifies contestant.
17. Added weights cannot extend past rear tires.
18. Maximum horsepower is 14 hp.
19. Pumped gas only!

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STOCK APPEARING AND PRO STOCK CLASSES

Special Rules for Stock Appearing and Pro Stock Classes:

1. Open to 16 and older contestants.
2. Cut tires allowed in these classes only.
3. Pull tractor in Stock or Stock Appearing and Pro Stock - Not both.
4. Entry fee - \$6.00 per entry - 90% payback.
5. Stock Appearing tractors are tractors with stock block for make and model being entered.
6. OEM production engines – Kohler, Briggs, Tecumsen, Onan – **NO AFTER MARKET BLOCKS.**
7. Stock Appearing tractors may be 1, 2 or 3 cylinders, gas or diesel, air or water cooled. All engines must be naturally

aspirate.

8. Engines must use stock, crank and cam in original position. No welding or cutting of jugs. Air restricting ventrui must be in stock position and no larger than 1.200. Choke may be removed. Vel. Stack permitted.
9. All ungoverned engines must use steel or aluminum flywheel. NO CAST FLYWHEELS.
10. Ungoverned engines must have head plates or straps – minimum of 1/4" x 2" or 3/8" x 3" aluminum. 1/8" steel or 3/16" aluminum side plate opposite cam side of engine – must cover full width of block and be fastened at both top and bottom of engine.
11. Clutch components must be covered 360 degrees with 1/8" steel or 1/4" aluminum.
12. No carburetor to intake spacers. Gasoline only – no alcohol. Fuel pumps permitted.
13. All exhaust must discharge vertically – 12" from bend minimum.
14. 23 x 10.50 x 12 maximum rear tire size – cutting is permitted.
15. Stock Appearing tractors – no less than 6" diameter wheels on front of tractor.
16. All tractors will have a seat with a back at least 6" high. All seats must be securely mounted. Tractors without backs will not be allowed to pull at this track for no reason other than safety.
17. Stock Appearing and Pro Stock tractors will have brakes in good working condition.
18. Stock Appearing and Pro Stock tractors will have a hood and grill in original position to be considered a legal entry.
19. All weights will be securely fastened. NO WEIGHTS TO EXTEND BEYOND REAR WHEELS.
20. Stock Appearing drawbars to be 10" from top of hitch to the ground, with a 1 1/2" diameter hole and a minimum of 1/2 " thick at the point of hitch.
21. Pro Stock drawbars will be 10" from the top of the hitch to the ground. They will also be parallel to the ground and stationary in all directions.
22. All tractors will have a safety device to prevent turnover (wheelie bars). This device will have wheels at least 1" wide and 5" in diameter or skid plates at least 3" square at the ground point. Wheels or skid plates will be at least 5" behind the rear tires and no more than 5" above the ground. Wheels or skid plates will be on both sides of the tractor and be strong enough to support the weight of the tractor while under pull.
23. Stock Appearing and Pro Stock tractors will have a kill switch located at the center of the rear of the tractor.
24. Stock Appearing tractor wheel base and axle placement must be in the original location. Tractors must have a reverse gear.
25. Front weight bars on Stock Appearing and Stock Pro Stock tractors must not exceed 8' from the center of the rear axle.
26. NO DUAL IGNITIONS ALLOWED !!!!
27. Gasoline only – no alcohol or pressurized fuel.
28. 16 hp and twin cylinders.
29. Steel flywheel required on over 14 hp.

RULES

1. Minimum age for contestants is 18.
2. All contestants must sign a waiver of liability.
3. 90% payback will apply for all classes.
4. No one will be allowed on track area except contestants and track officials. No helpers allowed. Only the driver is allowed in vehicle.
5. Vehicles must be run in low gear only.
6. The judges have the right to stop and disqualify the driver of any vehicle that is not being operated in a safe manner.
7. Violations of any rules shall constitute a disqualification.
8. All vehicles must be in neutral gear while being hitched and unhitched to the sled.
9. Vehicles must be stopped upon signal from the judge.
10. Consumption of alcoholic beverages prior to or during the pull will be cause for disqualification.
11. Number one puller may be a test puller and may take the pull if the weight machine is okay or may repull in third position.
12. All pulls start from a tight hitch. No jerking permitted. Contestants will be allowed two attempts in fifty feet. Puller must return to starting line for second attempt.
13. The pull will be considered over when the forward motion of the load stops. The judge will hold hole digging to a minimum.
14. All vehicles must have a current license plate and inspection sticker.
15. Added weights must be secured to vehicle.
16. Ring or clevis-type hook must meet the approval of the committee.
17. Excessive loss of liquid by a vehicle while in forward motion during pull will be disqualified unless due to internal breakage.
18. No visual modifications to engine are permitted.
19. Dual wheels are allowed in 7500 lb. Class only.
20. Maximum draw bar height is 24 inches.
21. One driver per truck.
22. Committee reserves the right to change rules if necessary.
23. No solid suspension, must have at least 2 inches of travel.
24. No suspension modifications other than an added leaf.
25. Must have D.O.T. approved tires.
26. Hitch must be at rear most part of vehicle.
27. Exhaust must run through the muffler.
28. Must run pump gas; no racing fuels, alcohol or diesel additives.
29. No weight on the front of the truck or in the cab of the truck.
30. No cut tires.

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SMALL BLOCK/MODIFIED/FACTORY BLOCK TRUCKS

Registration 12:00 noon – Pull Starts 1:00 p.m.
Competition Track
Entry Fee \$6.00 Per Class. ATV may only pull 1 time Per Class
100% Payback

RULES

1. ATV must have a secure hitch that is stationary in all directions with a maximum hitch height of 12 inches and a 1-inch minimum hole in hitch. This hitch may not extend more than 12 inches from the center of the rear axle.
2. ATV must use only two driving wheels. No duals are allowed.
3. ATV must use only rubber tires. No chains or studs are allowed.
4. ATV must have working brakes, fenders over the two rear tires, and a spring return throttle (level or twist grip).
5. No bike can be entered in more than 3 classes.
6. All drivers must be at least 16 years of age and be able to provide proof of age.
7. All ATV's must be operated in a safe manner on and off the track. No speeding or wheelies are allowed.
8. All drivers must wear a shirt, pants, boots, and a helmet during a pull.
9. No alcohol is allowed, violators will be disqualified.
10. All ATV's except Showroom Stock, must have a wheelie bar, and the wheelie bar must keep the front tire from lifting more than 18 inches off the ground.
11. The first Puller is the "Test Puller" in each class. He/she has the option to re-pull in 3rd or last spot. However, he/she will be giving up their first pull in doing so. Decision to re-pull must be made before the bike leaves the track.
12. All ties must be pulled off to determine placing.
13. If the puller goes out of bounds during the pull, you are done. This includes bike and/or sled.
14. The puller will be given two consecutive attempts to start the sled within 50 feet.
15. All pulls will start with a tight hitch. No jerking is allowed.
16. The loss of any object while hooked to the sled will be a disqualification, except for mechanical breakdowns.
17. If ATV has been entered and scratched, a refund of the entry fee may be allowed only if mechanical problems existing before the pull cannot be fixed before the pull. The officials' decision on such a matter is final.
18. No weights can extend more than 6 inches in front of and/or rear of the tires, wheelie bar excluded.
19. Only pump gas is permitted for use as fuel.
20. All rules will be settled by the judges and their decisions are final.
21. All entries are stopped once the first bike of that class hooks to the sled.
